### Author categories

Both scholars and practitioners are invited to send in a presentation abstract or summary. Guidelines differ according to whether you are a scholar or practitioner, so please ensure you download the appropriate guidelines below.

### Presentation Topics

We welcome presentations on the following three topics:

- 1) Green Science:** Biophysical and social science in support of vineyard greening
- 2) Green Design:** Design of vineyard greening (i.e. location, dimensions, and its composition) at different spatial and time scales, and successes and failures.
- 3) Green Implementation:** Implementation and Management of vineyard greening and its successes and failures.

### Abstract Submission

Submit your abstract to [Suphicha.muangsri@lincolnuni.ac.nz](mailto:Suphicha.muangsri@lincolnuni.ac.nz) by February 17, 2020. Please use the template to submit your presentation abstract/summary. Your abstract/summary must be submitted in Word document format. After submission, authors will be acknowledged of the receipt of their abstract/summary via an email within three working days. All abstracts will be peer-reviewed by at least two anonymous referees. Feedback will be provided to the authors. Authors will be informed of whether their presentation is accepted by March 23, 2020. Authors of accepted abstracts will be invited to submit a full paper and present their research at the symposium. Accepted papers will be, with the agreement of the authors, published in the symposium's proceedings and/or a special issue of a peer-reviewed journal or non-peer reviewed magazine depending on whether the author is a scholar or practitioner.

### Length of Oral Presentations

Each presentation is 15 to 20 minutes length followed by Q&A depending on the number of abstracts/summaries received. Authors will be informed of the length at the time of acceptance.
